Sunday, June 2: Depart for Ireland

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport via Aer Lingus on our transatlantic flight to Dublin, Ireland. Complimentary dinner, breakfast, and beverages will be served during the flight.

Day 2 Monday, June 3: Arrive in Dublin I Titanic Belfast

Arrive at Dublin Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet our Peter's Way tour manager/guide as we exit from Customs. Board our motor coach and we will be on our way to Belfast, the capital of Northern Ireland (2.5-hour drive). Enjoy a "Welcome to Ireland" group lunch in a traditional Irish Pub. After lunch, continue to Belfast. Upon arrival we will visit Titanic Belfast, an attraction that recreates the story of the world's most famous ship in a new iconic, six-floor building right beside the historic site of the original ship's construction. After our visit, we will stop at Belfast Castle for a photo opportunity. Check-in at our hotel and enjoy the balance of the day at leisure. Independent dinner. (B,L) Overnight at our hotel in Belfast.

Day 3 Tuesday, June 4: Giant's Causeway | Derry

Irish breakfast at our hotel. After celebrating morning Mass at St. Peter Cathedral, we'll have an orientation tour of Belfast, including the Falls Road sites, Bobby Sands Mural, and the Peace Wall. Then we'll leave Belfast and drive north to visit Dunluce Castle, located on the edge of County Antrim (30-minute drive). Independent lunch. We'll visit the Giant's Causeway, formed more than 60 million years ago. Red-hot lava erupted onto the surface of the earth and was quickly cooled by the sea, which crystalized it and formed 40,000 basalt polygonal columns. After our visit, we'll continue to Derry, situated between the sea and the mountains on the River Foyle (1-hour drive). Derry was created as a symbol of the Plantation of Ulster. Check-in at our hotel in Derry.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Derry. (B,D)

Day 4 Wednesday, June 5: Sligo I Knock I Galway

Irish breakfast at our hotel. This morning our guide will take us on a walking tour of Derry. We will see St. Augustine's Church, the Bloody Sunday Memorial, and Guildhall. The Guildhall was the location for the Saville Inquiry, the official investigation into the events of Bloody Sunday. As we leave Derry and drive to Sligo (2hour drive), we will see the beautiful scenery that inspired Irish poet W.B. Yeats. Independent lunch.

Continue to Ireland's National Marian Shrine in Knock (1-hour drive). The story of Knock began on the evening of August 21, 1879, when the Virgin Mary, St. Joseph, and St. John the Evangelist appeared at the south gable of the church at Knock. Beside them was an altar with a cross and the figure of a lamb, around which angels hovered. There were fifteen official witnesses to the apparition who watched and prayed for two hours in the pouring rain. Since then, this Marian Shrine has attracted millions of pilgrims each year from all over the world. The special message of Knock is the need for penance. Celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Apparition. Late afternoon we'll continue to Galway (1.5-hour drive).

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Galway.

Day 5 Thursday, June 6: Aran Islands

Irish breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll take the ferry (40-minute trip) from the mainland to Inis Mór, the largest of the Aran Islands. As we drive across the island, take in breathtaking scenery, ecclesiastical ruins from early Christian times, medieval castles, prehistoric stone forts, sandy beaches, unique flora and fauna, and the majestic cliffs of the Atlantic Ocean. Independent lunch. Late afternoon, return to the mainland. This evening, we'll have dinner at Padraichin's Seafood Bar and Restaurant with live music.

Overnight at our hotel in Galway. (B,D)

Day 6 Friday, June 7: Burren Region | Cliffs of Moher | Killarney

Irish breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with Mass at Galway Cathedral. After Mass, we'll leave Galway and drive through the spectacular Burren Region, which got its name from its polished limestone landscape (1.5-hour drive). It is hard to believe that it was once lightly wooded and covered in soil. At the end of the Stone Age, farmers arrived and left their animals grazing. This, along with natural weathering, stripped the soil of vegetation, leaving this rocky landscape behind. The region is heaven for geologists and botanists, with its rich flora and fauna. Stop at the Cliffs of Moher, the most majestic cliffs in Ireland. They rise from the Atlantic Ocean at 215 meters high and extend for over seven kilometers. From this height, on a clear day you can see the Aran Islands and Connemara Mountains. Independent lunch at the Cliffs of Moher. After lunch we'll take the Shannon Ferry across the Shannon Estuary and continue to Killarney for hotel check-in.

(B,D) Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Killarney.

Day 7 Saturday, June 8: Ring of Kerry I Muckross House

Irish breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll depart for the Ring of Kerry (1-hour drive), the most famous panoramic route in Ireland. The astonishing beauty of the Iveragh peninsula comes from the great diversity of its scenery, which offers incessant contrasts. En route around the Ring, take in spectacular scenery: mountains, peat bogs, lakes, and magnificent views of the Atlantic Ocean. Leaving Killarney, we'll pass through Killorglin, famous for its Puck Fair, then to Glenbeigh where the cliff road affords panoramic views of the Dingle Peninsula and Dingle Bay. Continuing to Cahirciveen, we'll pass the birthplace of Ireland's national hero, Daniel O'Connell. We'll continue on through peat bogs to the town of Waterville and to Sneem Village, famous for its brightly colored houses. The road continues through the mountains to Molls Gap and Ladies View, with superb views of the famous Lakes of Killarney. Independent lunch.

Visit Muckross House & Gardens. Muckross is a magnificent Victorian mansion built in 1843 and one of Ireland's leading stately homes. Built on the shores of Muckross Lake, it is beautifully situated amidst the spectacular scenery of Killarney National Park. The elegantly furnished rooms portray the lifestyle of the landed gentry, while downstairs in the basement area we can experience the working conditions of the servants employed in the house. The Gardens of Muckross House are famed for their beauty worldwide. In particular they are noted for their collections of azaleas and rhododendrons. The extensive water garden, the children's sunken garden, and the outstanding rock garden, hewn out of natural limestone, are just some of the features to be discovered. Celebrate Mass at St.

Mary's Cathedral or Franciscan Church in Killarney.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Killarney. (B,D)

Day 8 Sunday, June 9: Rock of Cashel | Kildare | Dublin

Irish breakfast at our hotel. Today, we'll leave Killarney and head to Dublin. On the way we will visit the Rock of Cashel (2-hour drive). Possibly the most photographed site in Ireland, the Rock of Cashel is one of Ireland's leading tourist attractions. Towering over the town of Cashel from its perch on a 200-foot outcrop of limestone, the Rock of Cashel was once the seat of the Kings of Munster. St. Patrick visited the rock in 450, while Brian Boru was crowned the first High King of Ireland here in the tenth century. Today, impressive stonewalls enclose a round tower, cathedral, 12th century Romanesque chapel, and High Crosses. Celebrate Sunday Mass in Cashel. Independent lunch.

We'll continue to visit Kildare (1-hour drive). Kildare dates back to the fifth century, when St. Brigid founded a monastery here. We'll visit Kildare's historic buildings, including the castle of the Earls of Kildare; the black, white, and grey abbey; a thirteenth century cathedral; and a ninth century round tower. Also located here are the Japanese gardens, acclaimed as one of the finest gardens in Europe. After our visit we'll continue to Dublin for hotel check-in (1-hour drive).

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Dublin. (B,D)

Day 9 Monday, June 10: Highlights of Dublin I Farewell Dinner Irish breakfast at our hotel. Celebrate morning Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes Church and Shrine of Venerable Matt Talbott. After Mass, we will explore Dublin's "Fair City!" This tour will allow us to take in all the sights, including the famous "Doors of Dublin," the elegant Georgian squares, and Phoenix Park. Highlights of the tour will be a visit to Trinity College to view the 8th century illustrated manuscript, The Book of Kells, followed by a visit to St. Patrick's Cathedral, made famous by its former dean Jonathan Swift, author of Gulliver's Travels

Independent lunch. Free afternoon to explore Dublin on your own. Perhaps you would like to visit the National Gallery of Ireland. This would also be a good time to visit the Guinness Storehouse to learn how this famous brewery was established and how the popular black brew is created. Or, take a stroll down Grafton Street, where you can do some great shopping. For those that want to explore more of Ireland's rebellious past, pay a visit to Kilmainham Gaol, where you can learn about the leaders from the 1916 uprising who were kept in this jail.

Option: Golfers may enjoy an optional visit to Island Golf Club, located 30 minutes from Dublin City Center. Established in 1890, the classic links course is bordered by the sea on three sides and features a rugged terrain, nestled between the highest sand dunes along the east coast of Ireland. Optional \$300 per person (transfers are not included).

This evening, enjoy dinner and entertainment at The Merry Ploughboy Pub. The welcoming atmosphere, fine food, and a lively show featuring contemporary

Irish dancing and well-known guest artists will be an amazing ending to our time in Ireland.

Overnight at our hotel in Dublin.

After our final Irish breakfast, we will be transferred by coach to Dublin Airport for our flight home.
